1. Report of the President

Malcolm Jackson provided an overview of discussions at the SFRRI Committee Meeting held on Friday 7 September at Imperial College London. The consensus view was that SFRRI should serve as an 'umbrella' organization with regional SFRR Societies hosting biennial meetings. There was a proposal from the Executive for future SFRRI Biennial Meetings to adopt the successful planning and transparent selection of research symposia, plenary lectures and abstracts for oral communication. Malcolm Jackson further proposed that a rotation of SFRRI between Europe, Asia and the Americas could provide long-term stability for future of SFRRI meetings.

To underpin the SFRRI website, the SFRRI Executive sought the advice of the SFRRI Committee concerning the possibility of charging a sponsorship fee for peer-reviewed journals to be listed on the SFRRI website. This was initially proposed by Anthony Newman from Elsevier as a means of supporting maintenance of the SFRRI website. This option was being explored further by a small working group to ensure that the selection of specific journals would be transparent and based on the academic standing of the journal and that Publishers could provide evidence that a Journal Publication Committee is closely involved in reviewing appointments of Editors and has an Publications Ethics Committee. Malcolm Jackson agreed to consult further with all the regional SFRR Societies.

Helen Griffiths enquired whether SFRRI should increase membership fees, but for the fore-seeable future fees would be kept at present rates. Henry Forman mentioned that an increase in fees would be in £ and that this income had decreased in value due to the exchange rate. Henry Forman further enquired how SFRRI spent its income, and suggested that SFRRI could run an abstract service linking all journals' abstracts. Other suggestions included setting up an outreach programme, similar to SFRBM, which would appeal to the membership.

2. Report of the Secretary-General

Giovanni Mann reported on the SFRRI 2012 conference and highlighted future SFRRI meetings (see point 6 below). SFRRI 2012 had a total of 582 registered delegates, 5 plenary/keynote lectures, 16 research symposia, 72 oral presentations and 565 poster presentations. The conference had received generous financial support from SFRBM, SFRR-Europe, SFRR-Asia, SFRR-International and Oxygen Club of California. Major financial support for the 16 research symposia was obtained from the Biochemical Society and Seahorse, Mars Incorporated, Kyowa, as well as, support from Qiagen, Biosyn, Alltech, Bertin Pharma, Bioquote Ltd, PromoCell, Don Whitley Scientific, BMG Labtech, Abcam, LabLogic, Magnettech, Ruskinn-The Baker Company, Bruker, IOS Press, Informa Healthcare, Antioxidant Redox Signaling, Food & Function. As conference organizers Elsevier had also committed major resources to underpin the conference by waiving registration fees for all invited speakers, including the three Satellite meetings held on Wednesday 5 September.

Corinne Spickett enquired about profits expected from SFRRI 2012 and how these profits would be split between SFRR-International and the hosts SFRR-Europe. Giovanni Mann agreed to liaise with the SFRRI Executive and to inform SFRRE of the proposed split of profits from the SFRRI 2012 meeting in London, 5-9 September.

3. Report of the Treasurer

Cesar Fraga reported that the successful transfer of the SFRRI account/funds from Credit Swiss to HSBC in London. He further commented that SFRRI could consider additional sources of income. Financial accounts were presented by Cesar Fraga, and he agreed to circulate the finalised financial accounts to the regional SFRR Societies.

4. Report of the President-Elect

Michael Davies highlighted that the SFRRI Statutes and Charter require updating and agreed to undertake this during the next few months.

5. Nominations and elections

Giovanni Mann reported that an online voting template for the election of President-Elect had been sent to all regional SFRR Societies, asking them to cascade this to their members. Prof Frank Kelly and Prof Rafael Radi were nominated and agreed to stand. The deadline for the receipt of online votes was 12 September 2012, and Prof Rafael Radi was elected as the next SFRRI President-Elect and will be taking up office on 1 January 2013. Prof Michael Davies will be succeeding Prof Malcolm Jackson as the new SFRRI President on 1 January 2013.

6. Future meetings

The 17th Biennial SFRRI Meeting will be organised by Yuji Naito and Shinya Toyokuni on behalf of SFRR-Asia and be held in Kyoto, Japan from 23-26 March 2014. Yuji Naito and Shinya Toyokuni have invited the submission of symposium proposals with a deadline of 1 February 2013 (http://www.sfrri2014.org/call_for_symposia.htm). The organisation of SFRRI 2014 will largely adopt the guidelines of the successful SFRRI 2012 conference held in London.

Giovanni Mann proposed that SFRRI 2014 should be supported by the regional SFRR Societies, similar to the support of SFRRI 2012 in London. A bid for the 18th Biennial SFRRI Meeting had been received from SFRR-Africa, and Giovanni Mann mentioned that there may be other bids received in due course. All bids for future SFRRI Biennial Meetings could complete an application form, including information on the venue, dates of the meeting, Local Organising Committee, International Advisory Board, International Scientific Programme Committee, registration fee, accommodation, arrangements for invited Plenary Lectures, submission of Symposium proposals and Abstracts.

7. Any other matters

Lin Mantell (SFRBM) queried why attendance was so low at the SFRRI General Assembly. A possible explanation was the very full programme at SFRRI 2012, but the consensus was that in future the SFRRI General Assembly required better advertising.
